## **LANE CLOSURE SCHEDULED FOR ASPHALT WORK IN WILKINSON COUNTY**

**WHEN:** 7:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., Monday, October 15, continuing through Thursday, October 18, weather permitting

**WHERE:** State Route 57, mile marker 15.8-17.9; mill and inlay

**WHAT:** Georgia DOT maintenance crews have scheduled a single lane closure for asphalt milling and inlay work on State Route 57 in Wilkinson County. Work is tentatively scheduled between 7:30 a.m. and 3:30 p.m., weather permitting.

Flagmen may be used for this work. Motorists are asked to use caution, reduce their speed and be alert to changing traffic conditions in work zones.
