### ***14th Street Improvement Project***

### **WEST PEACHTREE STREET CLOSURES BETWEEN 10TH AND PEACHTREE STREETS THIS WEEKEND**

**WHEN:** 8 p.m. Friday, April 24 continuously through 5 a.m., Monday April 27, weather permitting.

**WHERE:** West Peachtree Street in Midtown Atlanta between 10th and Peachtree streets.

- Between 10th and 12th streets West Peachtree Street will be reduced to two lanes (recommended for local traffic only).
- Between 12 and 17th streets West Peachtree Street will be closed to all traffic.
- Between 17th and Peachtree streets West Peachtree Street will be reduced to two lanes.

*Please Note: West Peachtree Street will be blocked to all cross traffic within the work area.*

**WHAT:** Crews will be milling and resurfacing West Peachtree Street through the weekend. This work is related to the 14th Street Bridge Improvement Project.

**Detour signage will be in place throughout the work area. Police officers will be stationed at key intersections to direct traffic flow.**

Motorists traveling north on West Peachtree Street will be detoured:

- right onto 10th Street
- left onto Peachtree Street
- left onto 17th Street
- right back onto West Peachtree Street

A more detailed traffic plan is available upon request.
