Hours of Service (HOS) & Electronic Logging Devices (ELD) Webinar, 1/12/18 - The Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration ELD mandate compliance date was 12/18/17 and all carriers subject to the rule must use self-certified ELDs registered with FMCSA by 12/16/19. In this webinar, Mike McDonal provides guidance to rural agencies about the HOS regulations and ELD mandate, including management, technology and implementation.

Understanding the Updated USDOT Drug & Alcohol Testing Webinar, 12/12/17 - The USDOT's drug and alcohol testing regulation, 49 CFR Part 40, was revised on 11/13/17 and is effective 1/1/18. Robbie Sarles provides a summary of the changes and how they will impact transit systems. She describes the context of the revisions, the impact at the employer level, and what actions transit systems should make, including how to update your drug and alcohol testing policy. She also suggests best practices to educate your workforce and how it may affect employees.

Transit Acronym Dictionary - Available in the Resource Library, this document includes common government agencies, industry organizations, legislation and phrases used in the transit literature. Released November 2017.

Grant Writing 101 Webinar, 8/30/17 - This webinar provides guidance and best practices for writing grants, especially for FTA programs.
