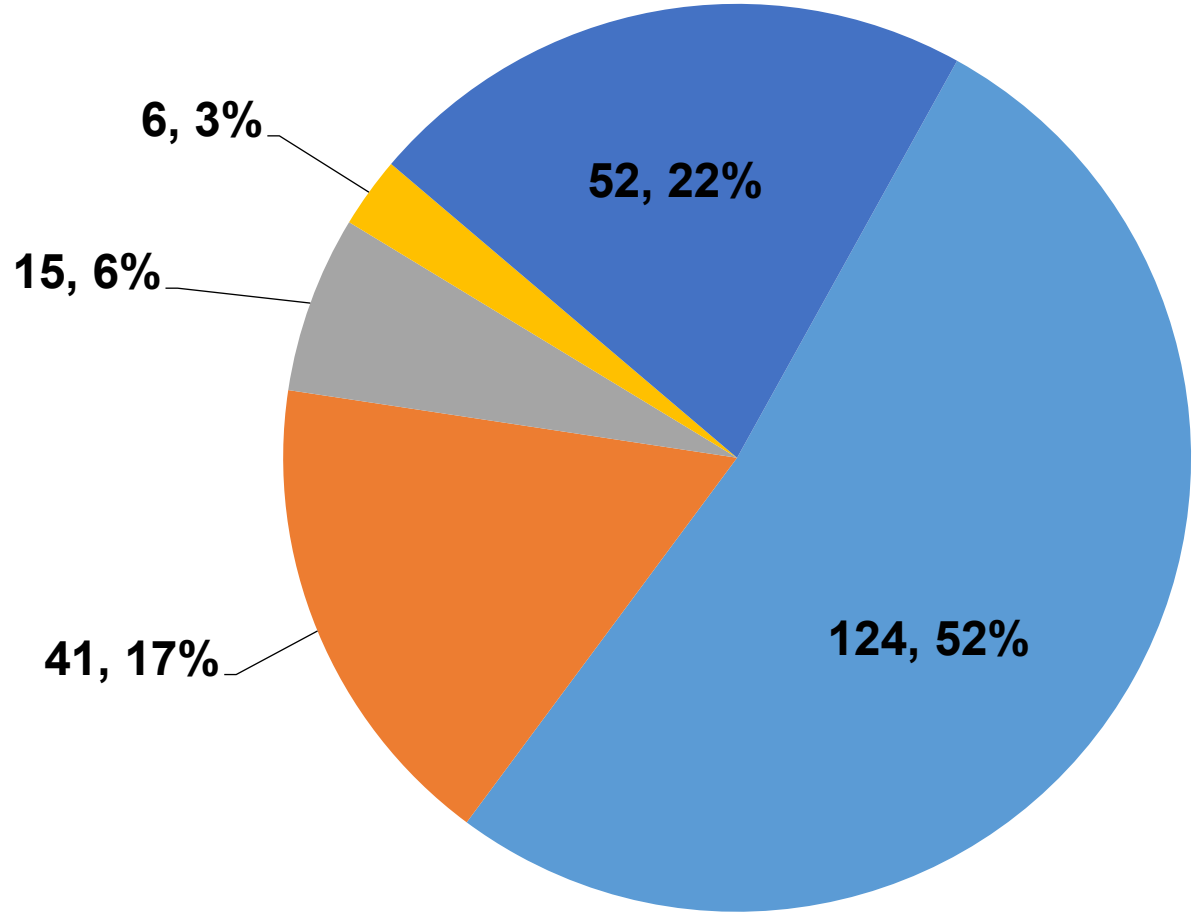

## Fiscal Year 2026 Letting Report Number of Projects Let in FY 2026 (Contractor Low Bid Award Data)



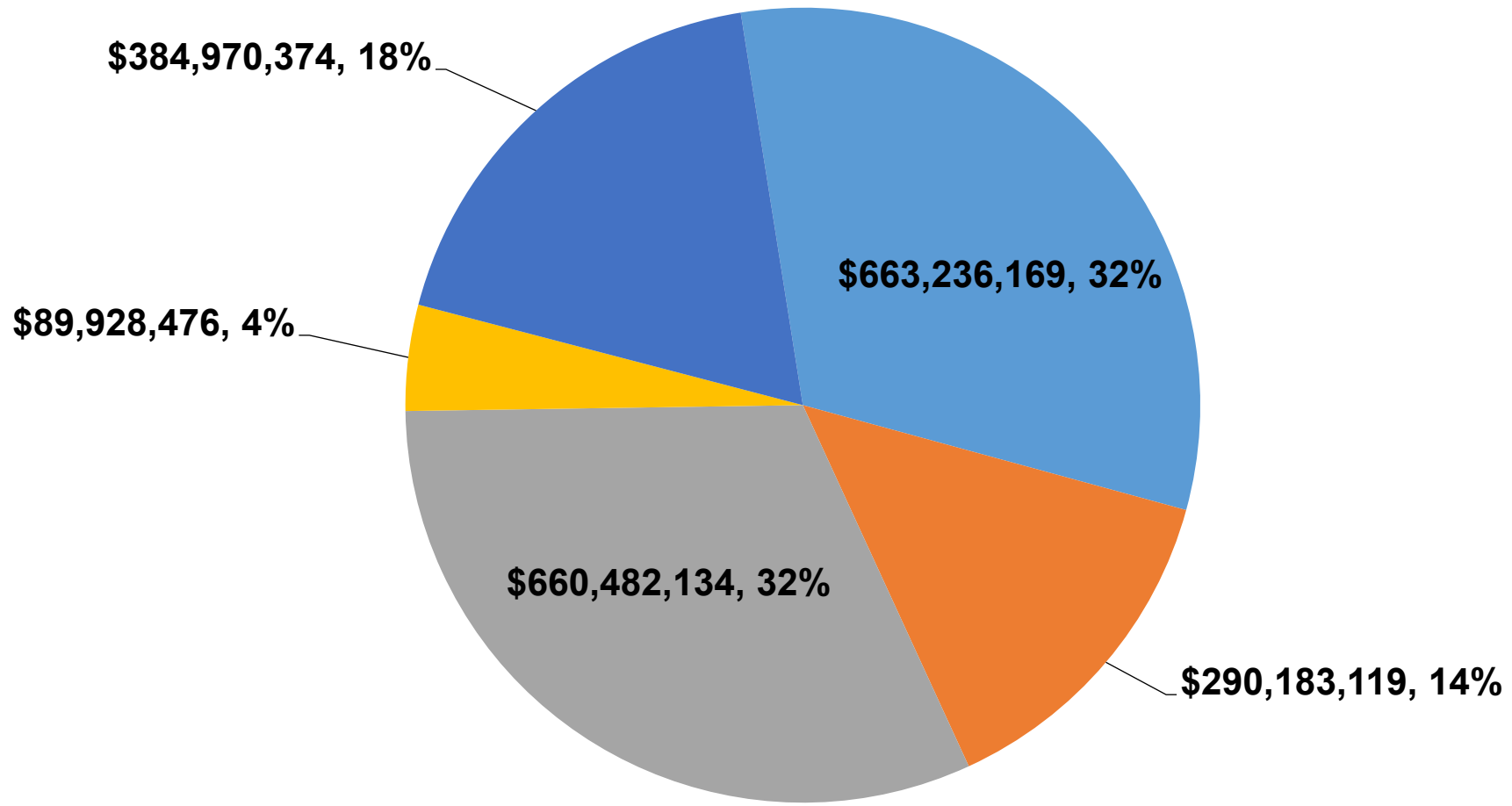

# Annual Transportation Code Section Update

## H.B. 1277 – Rep. Matt Barton

- Four key components:
  - Adjusts threshold for environmental reporting requirements from \$100m to \$200m and indexes to CPI moving forward.
  - Adjusts threshold to allow expedited disposal of real estate from \$75k to \$150k and indexes to CPI moving forward.
  - Streamlines submission of GDOT's annual reporting measures.
  - Removes the annual % project cost cap on the Design-Build delivery method.
- **Amendment adopted in Senate Transportation provided a one-year extension for the Georgia Department of Agriculture to implement its EV charger safety oversight and permitting.**
- Received final passage in the Senate and House on April 2<sup>nd</sup>.



# Airport Height Zoning Requirements

## H.B. 1434 – Rep. Jenkins



- Requires airport sponsors to identify their “airport affected area.”
  - Governing bodies within must adopt regulations to restrict the height of buildings, structures and natural objects.
- GDOT to provide assistance and guidance regarding the compliance of such regulations with FAA requirements.
- Failure to enact or enforce regulations shall result in suspension of LMIG program funding for the airport affected governing body.
- **Senate Transportation Committee Amendment—qualified further GDOT’s assistance is with respect to confirming compliance with FAA requirements.**
- Received final passage in the House and Senate on April 2<sup>nd</sup>.

# School Zone Speed Cameras

**H.B. 1161 and H.B. 651 – Rep. Alan Powell & Sen. Randy Robertson**

- Requires speed camera warning signs (**H.B. 651**) and “Your Speed” feedback signs (**H.B. 1161**) be installed with yellow flashing lights.
- Establishes fines for local governing authorities that abuse the use of the cameras and provides for a process for the suspension of the permit with a hearing and appeal process. (**H.B. 651**)
- Cameras may continue to operate from **1 hour before** the start of school **throughout** the day until **1 hour after** school though only speeds above 10mph over speed limit may be ticketed. (**H.B. 651**)
- Requires annual report from local governing authority on revenue generated and prohibits cameras on 4 lane highways with no crosswalks. (**H.B. 1161**)
- Effective 07/01/27, requires local governing authority seek approval via referendum for a new contract or renewal of current contracts to operate such cameras. (**H.B. 651**)
  - “**Yes**” Vote authorizes operation for 6 years.
  - “**No**” Vote requires 3 year “cooling off” period before next referendum

# Transit SPLOST Referendums

## H.B. 328 – Rep. John Carson Amendment



- Within Metro Atlanta, when a county Transit SPLOST referendum fails to secure approval, the county is subject to an 8-year “cool off” period before it can seek another Transit SPLOST referendum.
  - Prohibits the use of Transit SPLOST funds for “purposes of providing free or reduced fares for public transit services.”
  - No impacts to conventional Transportation SPLOSTS or TIA Regional SPLOSTs.
- Passed the House by a vote of 99 to 67 on March 31<sup>st</sup>.
  - Passed the Senate by a vote of 30 to 22 on April 2<sup>nd</sup>.

## GRTA/ATL Consolidation

**H.B. 297 – Sen. Jason Anavitarte and Rep. Victor Anderson**

- Abolishes the Georgia Regional Transportation Authority (GRTA) and reconstitutes the Atlanta Transit Link Authority (ATL) as the Georgia Transportation Efficiency Authority (GTEA).
- Assigns to GTEA the authority to be the approver of the Atlanta Regional Commission (ARC) TIP (when designated by the Governor) and approver of developments of regional impact (DRI)—previous powers of GRTA.
- ATL Authority's regional transit planning and coordination functions lapse back to the ARC with GTEA assuming the ATL's authority to be the designated recipient of federal transit funds in the region.



# GRTA/ATL Consolidation

H.B. 297 – Sen. Jason Anavitarte and Rep. Victor Anderson

- GTEA would operate the Xpress Bus Service and can be a transit operator to any jurisdiction in the state if approved by local referendum.
- GTEA Board Constitution: 8 appointees by Governor; 2 appointed by Lt. Governor, 2 appointed by Speaker, (serving 5-year terms) and the GDOT Commissioner as an ex-officio, voting member.
- Amendment included to extend the MARTA sales tax to 2067.
- Passed the House (131 to 40) and Senate (38 to 14) on April 2<sup>nd</sup>.
