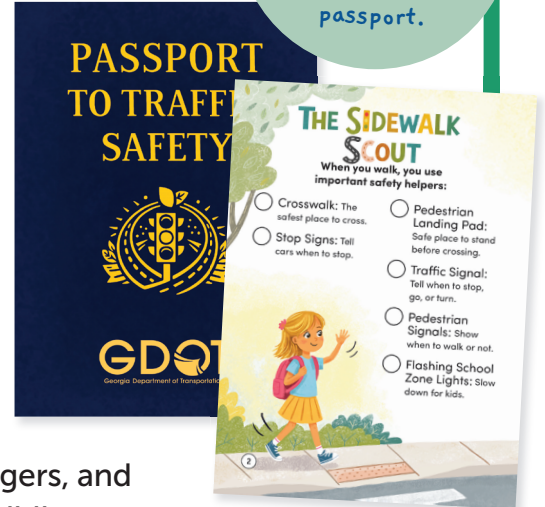
A FREE K-12 CAR AND ROAD
