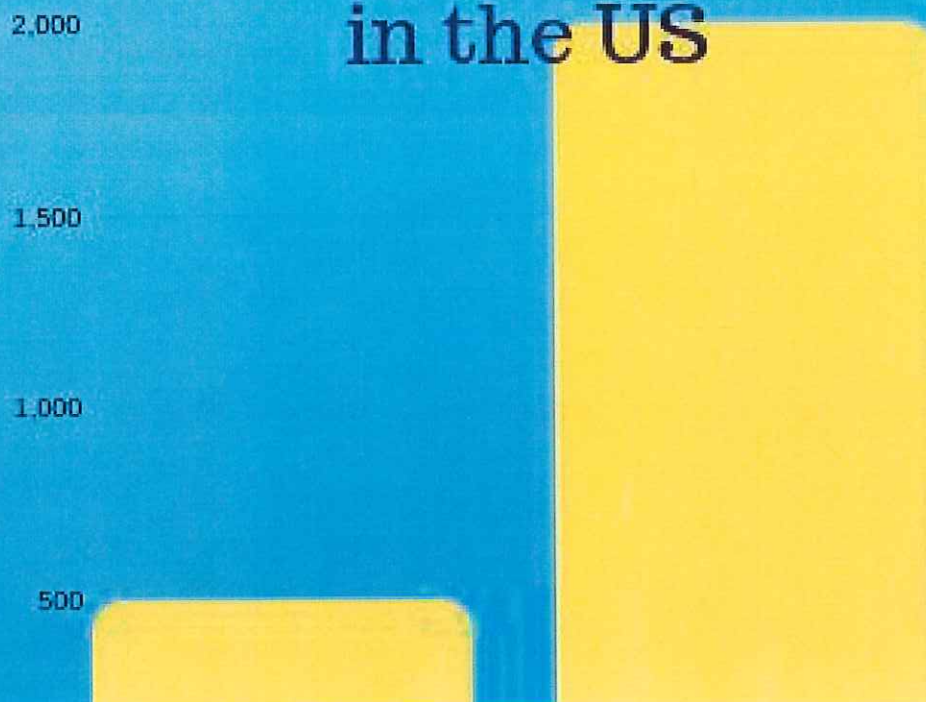

- 3. Speeding**

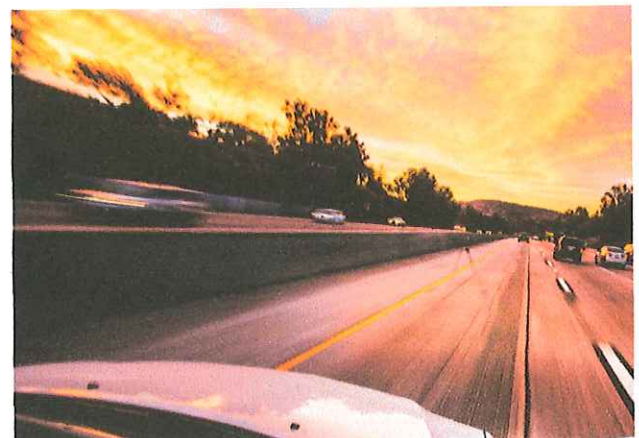
Distracted driving accounts for approximately 25% of all fatal car crashes.
