

# Competitive Funding Proposal for TA and CMAQ

## Overview

The Georgia Department of Transportation (GDOT) is administering a Competitive Funding Proposal (CFP) for Transportation Alternatives (TA) and Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality (CMAQ) Improvement programs. This process is designed to streamline project intake and evaluation, simplifying the application process for locals seeking federal funding support.

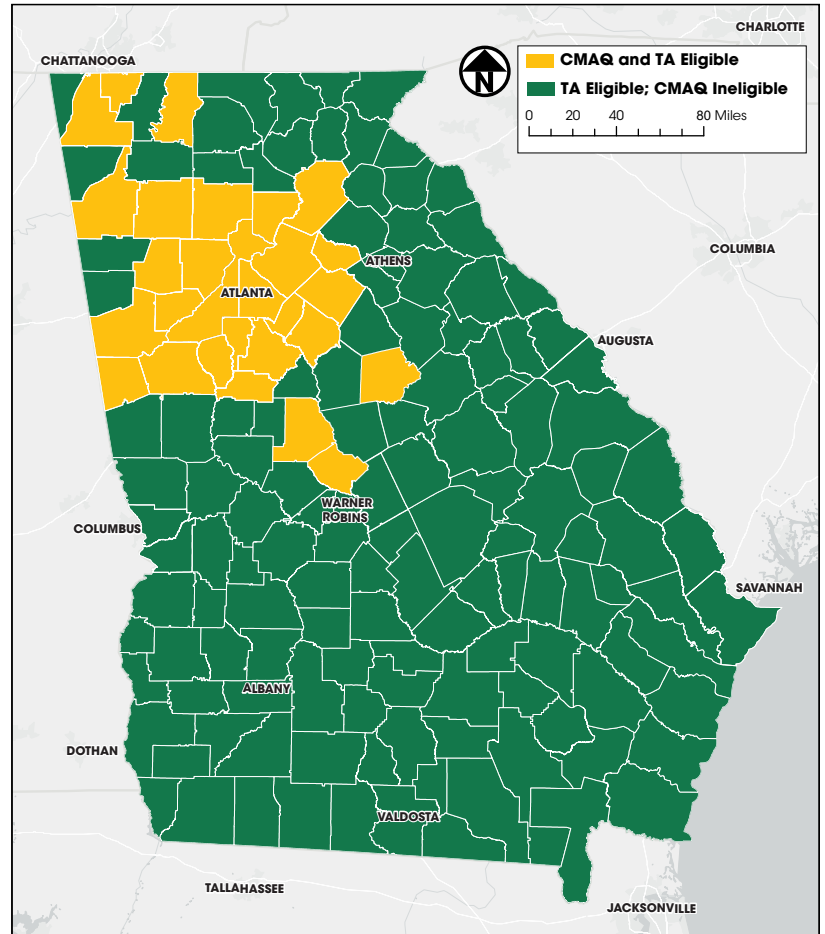
## Key Facts

- Funding applications will be accepted **September 15, 2025**, through **October 31, 2025**

- Am I Eligible?

**Please review the criteria below before proceeding with your application. If you answer "no" to any of these questions, you should not apply:**

- ☐ Is your agency or organization an eligible applicant?
  - ☐ Is the project type eligible in your area? Please reference the [CFP Overview](#) for TA and CMAQ project eligibility.
  - ☐ Do you have at least 20% local match for the project phase for which you are applying for funding support? (Supporting documentation must be provided).  
*Some eligible projects may qualify for a higher share of federal dollars based on project type, population, and roadway classification. Please visit [TA](#) and [CMAQ websites](#) for more information.*
  - ☐ Is your agency or organization able to cover project expenses as the project progresses and be reimbursed for no more than 80% of eligible project costs as invoices are submitted?

- Projects will be evaluated for eligibility against TA and CMAQ program requirements.
