A. General Description

Use this procedure to sample water.

Water is designated as two types:

- Water suitable for drinking that is used for ordinary household purposes
- Water from all other sources
- 1. Household Water
 - a. Accept water used for ordinary household purposes without testing. Do not take samples of this water.
 - b. Write a statement in the Project Diary that identifies the location of the supply and that the water is used for drinking and household purposes.
- 2. Water from All Other Sources
 - a. Take samples of water from all other sources.
 - b. Place a 1 qt (1 L) sample in a clean glass or plastic container and carefully pack it for shipment.
 - c. Identify the sample on Form 170.
 - d. Submit the sample directly to the Office of Materials and Research at least 10 days before using the water.
 - e. Report the test results on Form 168.
