A. General Description

Use this procedure to sample paint.

1. Pre-tested Paint

Paint is normally pre-tested and will arrive on the Project in a container marked with the GDT number.

If the paint does not have the GDT identification number, or if the paint is labeled with a date of manufacture over six months old, you must sample and test it before use.

NOTE: The Engineer may decide to sample and test paint at any time.

- a. Note the manufacturer's lot number during the inspection.
- b. For each lot, determine whether or not sampling is necessary or desired.
- 2. Untested Paint
 - a. Properly mix the paint before sampling.
 - 1) Use a mechanical stirrer to properly mix the paint.
 - 2) Mix the paint until it has a uniform consistency.
 - b. Take one quart (one liter) of paint as a sample.
 - c. Submit the sample directly to the Office of Materials and Research.
 - d. Fill out Form 170 for each sample. Include the manufacturer, lot number, type of paint, and quantity represented.
 - e. Report test results on Form 138.
