Supplemental Agreements	

Once a PCE Request is Accepted

- GDOT Engineering Services (ES) tracks the progress of construction
- ES coordinates with GDOT District Construction and GDOT Project Manager on when to hold the PCE
- ES schedules the PCE per the GDOT PDP (may be a virtual meeting)
- ES prepares and distributes draft report before the meeting
- ES facilitates the meeting and prepares and distributes final PCE Report

- **Who Can Request a PCE – Anyone involved with the project**
- **When Can a Request be Submitted – When the GDOT Let Project has been advertised for letting or the project is under construction**
- **Before You Submit a Request – Ensure your office/firm will participate in the PCE**
- **How Do You Submit a Request – Email GDOT Asst. State Project Review Engineer chasty@dot.ga.gov or jotaylor@dot.ga.gov**
- **What Do You Include in the Request**
 PI Number and GDOT Let Date
 Reason(s) you believe a PCE on this project will provide benefit to GDOT, Consultant Industry, or Contracting Industry
 See GDOT PDP Section 8.5 for PCE Goals, Objectives, and Projects that typically need a PCE
 Your contact information
- **What Happens To Your Request**
