CSX Rail Crossing Updates to Impact SR 11 Traffic

FITZGERALD – CSX Railroad is planning to update two crossings in July, which will require state Route 11 detours.

The first detour is scheduled to begin at 8 a.m. July 10 and end at 6 p.m. July 13 for the crossing at Sherman Street. From SR 90/SR 11, traffic will be routed right onto SR 107 to Rhine Road, left onto Joshlyn Road, then right onto U.S. 129/SR 11 or straight on Lower Rebecca Road and then right onto SR 90.

The second detour is scheduled to begin at 8 a.m. July 11 and end at 5 p.m. July 14 for the Grant Street crossing. The detour route from SR 11 is left onto Joshlyn Road, right onto Rhine Road, straight at the junction of Rhine Road and SR 107, then left onto SR 11.

CSX will remove the existing track and roadbed, update the surface and install new crossing material.
