Rail Crossing Maintenance Will Impact State Route Traffic

ASHBURN – Upcoming maintenance at two rail crossings in Turner County will require temporary traffic detours on state Route 32 and U.S. 41/SR 7 this month.

The first detour on SR 32 is for work at the crossing between Main and Mill streets in Ashburn. It is scheduled to begin at 8 a.m. Jan. 25 and end at 5 p.m. Jan. 26. Westbound traffic will turn left on SR 7, right on West Madison Avenue, right on Mill Street and left to return to SR 32/112. Eastbound traffic will turn right on Mill Street, left on West Madison Avenue and right to return to SR 7/32 or left on SR 7 and then right to reach SR 112.

The second detour is on U.S. 41/SR 7 between Ashburn and Arabi. It is scheduled to begin at 8 a.m. Jan. 30 and end at 5 p.m. Jan. 31. Northbound traffic will turn right on SR 159 in Ashburn, get on Interstate 75 North, exit at Arabi/Exit 92, turn left on First Street and then right to return to SR 7. Southbound traffic will turn left on First Street in Arabi, get on I-75 South, exit at SR 159/Exit 84, turn right on SR 159 and turn left to return to SR 7.

All work is weather permitting and subject to be rescheduled.
