December 29, 2025 BITUMINOUS CONSTRUCTION BULLETIN TO ALL GEORGIA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION HOT MIX PRODUCERS AND ASPHALTIC CONCRETE CONTRACTORS

As you are aware, all QCT Level 2 Certified Technicians are permitted to recertify via completion of specified QCT training within the 3 year certification period in lieu of taking a written examination. This bulletin is being provided to notify you of the dates for the QCT Level 2 Training Workshops for **2026**. These classes will be offered via virtual meetings on the following dates.

The purpose of the GDOT's QCT Level 2 training is to provide review of process control adjustments to the asphalt plant operations to Quality Control Technician, inform technicians of changes or revision in GDOT's specifications and testing procedures and improve overall quality in bituminous materials production procedures.

As detailed below are the current requirements for initial certification and recertification that have been established.

Initial Certification Requirements

- Must have been previously certified as a Level I QCT
- Must have demonstrated Level 1 QCT Field Competencies to District TMOS

Option 3: One QCT Level 2 Training Workshop (6 hours) plus 6 hours of other eligible supplemental training, and 3 annual IA Evaluations (2 hours each for a total of 6 hours). 			
Regardless of other eligible training hours, IA evaluations are required yearly for active Acceptance Sample				
Testing certified QCT Level 2 technicians in accordance with SOP 30.
