Fact Sheet

What is the Project?

State Route 400 (SR 400) is a vital north-south transportation corridor in metro Atlanta that connects people, jobs, and freight. To improve mobility, Georgia DOT plans to add new, optional express lanes from the North Springs MARTA Station to McFarland Parkway. The project will add:

- Two buffer-separated express lanes in each direction between the North Springs MARTA Station and McGinnis Ferry Road
- One buffer-separated express lane in each direction from McGinnis Ferry Road to McFarland Parkway

5 Things You Need to Know

1. The express lanes will be managed by congestion pricing, rising as demand increases during peak travel times and falling at off-peak times, giving drivers the choice to pay a fee to bypass congestion.
2. The SR 400 Express Lanes will provide more reliable trips along the corridor.
3. Georgia's first bus rapid transit (BRT) system is planned to run along this project corridor. Once completed by MARTA, transit providers will have access to the express lanes at multiple access points along the corridor.
4. Transit riders and registered vanpools can use the lanes without paying any additional fees.
5. One of the large-scale Major Mobility Investment Program projects to improve transportation in Georgia's metro areas.

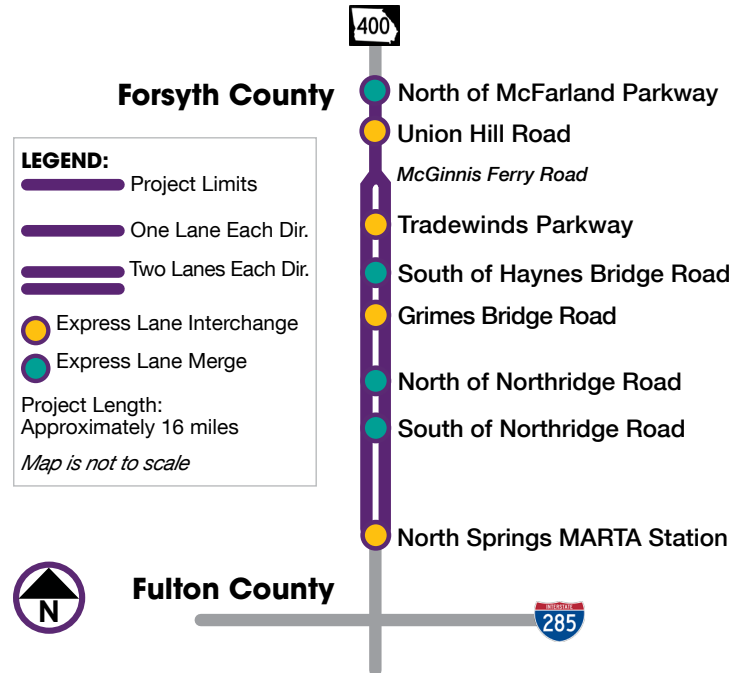
Related Projects

The SR 400 Express Lanes project connects with other future and existing Georgia DOT projects that will build a better Georgia by enhancing mobility and safety while fueling economic growth. The SR 400 Phase 1 Design-Build project has been pulled forward as part of a phased delivery of the planned SR 400 Express Lanes project.

The procurement process to select a developer for the SR 400 Express Lanes was cancelled in August 2021 but the SR 400 Express Lanes project has not been cancelled. Georgia DOT continues to view the SR 400 Express Lanes project as an important priority for Georgia. Georgia DOT is exploring options to advance the project. Project schedule impacts will be determined at a later date.
