

State Route (SR) 42 at Norfolk Southern (NS) Bridge Replacement Project

Fact Sheet

What is the Project?

This project proposes the replacement of the existing bridge along SR 42 over Norfolk Southern railroad and will remove the aging infrastructure to benefit the traveling public.

5 Things You Need to Know

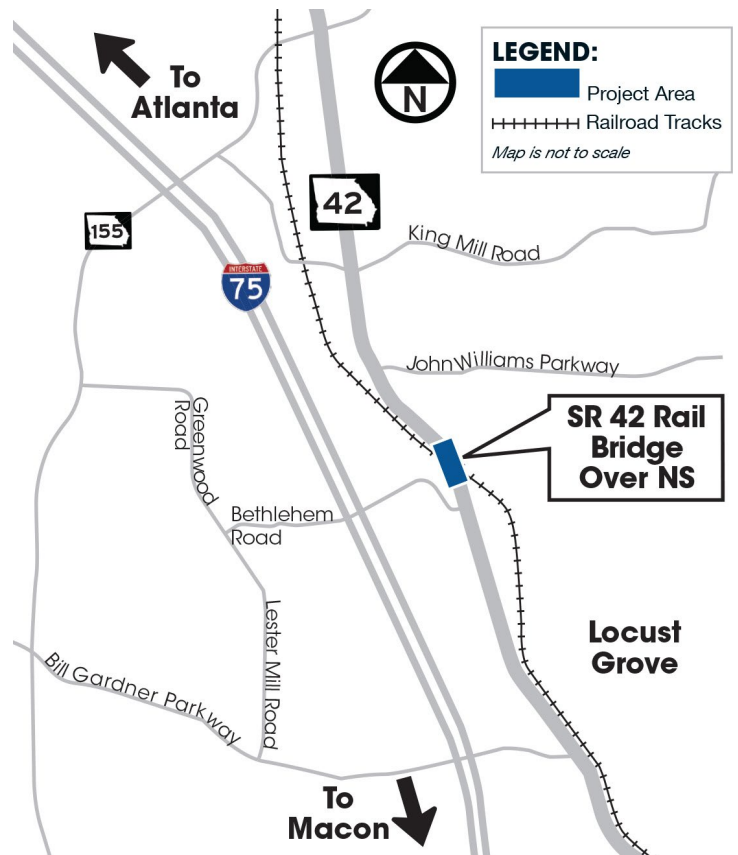
1. The existing bridge was originally constructed in 1938 and widened in 1979. This project will bring much needed improvements to this aging infrastructure, demonstrating Georgia's commitment to modernizing bridges statewide.
2. Overlaps with the [I-75 at Bethlehem Road Interchange project](#) (P.I. No. 0017182), south of the railroad crossing.
3. The new structure will be constructed east of the existing bridge but will otherwise tie into the existing alignment of SR 42.
4. Will accommodate two, additional railroad tracks to be constructed by Norfolk Southern in the future.
5. The existing bridge will remain open throughout construction of the new bridge, and no off-site detour is required.

What's the Status?

The Georgia Department of Transportation (Georgia DOT) recently selected a Design-Build (DB) team for the State Route (SR) 42 at Norfolk Southern (NS) Bridge Replacement Project in Henry County. E.R. Snell Contractor, Inc./BCC Engineering DBA Heath & Lineback was named the apparent successful proposer.

Final design is expected to start in Q1 2026. Construction of the project is expected in late 2026 with substantial completion anticipated in late 2028. This schedule is subject to change.
