What is the Project?

The proposed project would widen Interstate 16 (I-16) from two to three lanes east and westbound between I-95 and State Route (SR) 67 in Bulloch, Bryan, Effingham, and Chatham counties. Six bridges will be replaced at three locations and other bridges in the corridor will be widened.


5 Things You Need to Know

- 1. The project spans approximately 32 miles across Bulloch, Bryan, Effingham, and Chatham counties.
- 2. Six bridges will be replaced at three locations:
 - I-16 EB and WB at GA Central Railway
 - I-16 EB and WB at the Ogeechee River
 - I-16 EB and WB at the Ogeechee River overflow
- 3. There are no anticipated right-of-way impacts to properties along the corridor.
- 4. With an additional lane to support growing traffic volumes, the project is anticipated to increase mobility and level of service through the corridor.
- 5. I-16 is a vital corridor to and from the Georgia Ports, featuring the fastest growing port in the nation.

What's the Project Status?

Currently, the project is in early concept development, and various environmental and technical studies are underway. The project's first public meeting, a Public Information Open House (PIOH), was held in June 2025. Publication of the comment response letter is anticipated in September 2025.
