

Georgia National Electric Vehicle Infrastructure Deployment Program

Fact Sheet

What is the Program?

The Georgia National Electric Vehicle Infrastructure (NEVI) Deployment Program is derived from the 2021 [Bipartisan Infrastructure Law](#) enacted as the Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act. The goal of the Georgia NEVI Program is to deploy a national network of electric vehicle (EV) charging stations that provide a convenient, reliable, affordable, and equitable experience for all users. The program provides nearly \$5 billion nationally over five years beginning in the fall of 2022. [Georgia's allotment](#) from the formula program is approximately \$135 million to develop its portion of the national network.

Georgia will use their NEVI funds to build out alternative fuel corridors (AFC) throughout the state. AFC, as designated by the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA), are a network of alternative fueling and charging infrastructure along the national highway system.

5 Things You Need to Know

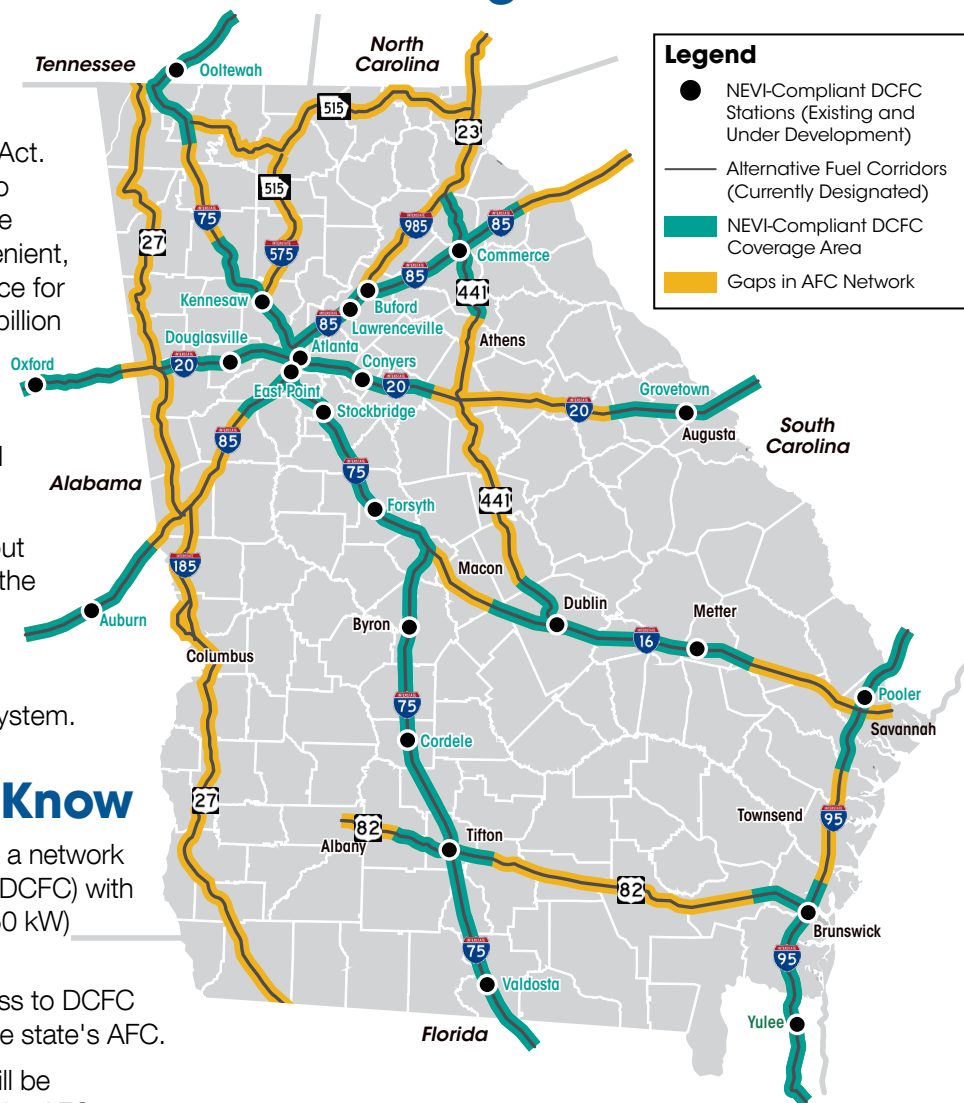
1. The Georgia NEVI Program will deploy a network of NEVI Compliant DC Fast Charging (DCFC) with minimum of four, high-power ports (150 kW) at each charging station.
2. Once completed, users will have access to DCFC charging ports every 50 miles along the state's AFC.
3. Georgia NEVI funded charging sites will be accessible within a 1-mile distance of the AFC.
4. Georgia NEVI funded charging sites will be open to the public 24/7.
5. Georgia DOT plans to build out the state's AFC network through multiple rounds of solicitations.

What's the Program's Status?

Georgia NEVI Deployment Plan was approved by FHWA on September 14, 2022. The Georgia NEVI Deployment Plan identified Gaps in AFC Network that are required to be addressed (noted in yellow on the map).

Round 2 of this program is currently in procurement.
