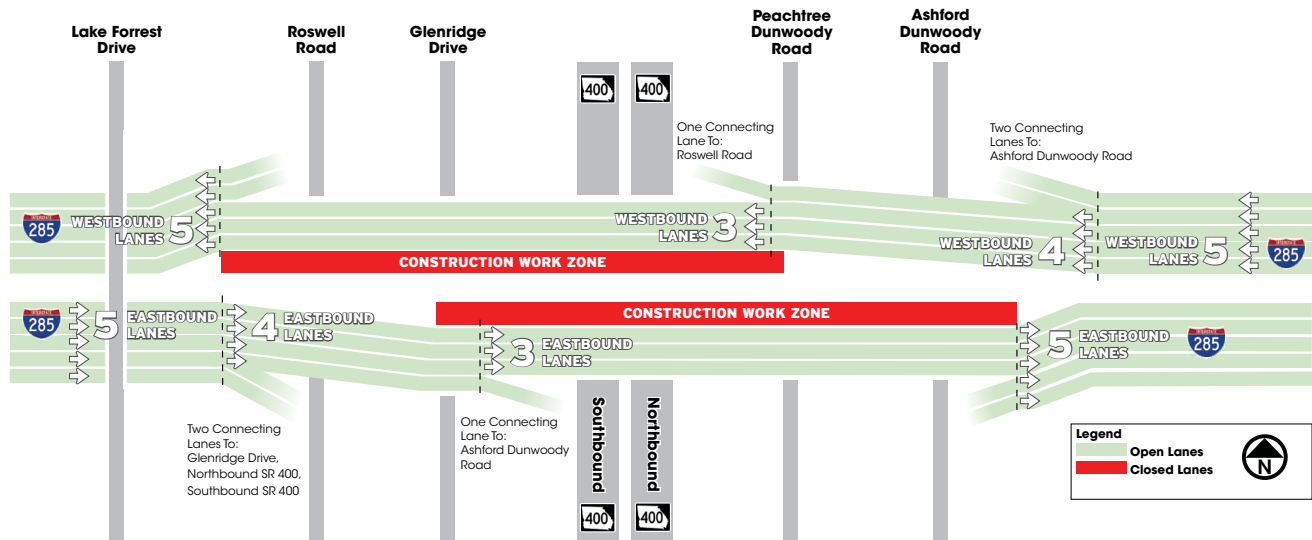


OVERVIEW

Georgia DOT construction partners will close lanes in both directions on Interstate 285 between Ashford Dunwoody Road and Roswell Road for bridge demolition and reconstruction at Glenridge Drive, State Route (SR) 400, and Peachtree Dunwoody Road. The bridge replacements and associated I-285 lane reductions will take at least eight months to complete. Motorists are advised to avoid I-285 in this area if possible. If your route includes this area rely on your preferred wayfinding apps for alternate routes and leave early.



I-285 LANE REDUCTIONS - PHASE 1



KEY THINGS TO KNOW

- The work will be performed in two phases:
 - Phase 1: Inside lanes will close on I-285 in each direction between Roswell Road to Ashford Dunwoody Road, so crews can reconstruct the interior portions of the I-285 bridges over Glenridge Drive, SR 400, and Peachtree Dunwoody Road. A minimum of three lanes will be open in each direction. This phase will take approximately four months.
 - Phase 2: Traffic will shift to the inside lanes providing width for three travel lanes and the existing outside lanes will close to traffic so crews can demolish and reconstruct the exterior portions of the bridges. This phase will take approximately four months.
- There will be a minimum of three lanes in each direction open on I-285, and the connecting lanes will remain open during the day
- Georgia DOT anticipates a major increase in traffic along I-285 so if you must travel through the project corridor, plan ahead and give yourself plenty of extra drive time
- Changeable message signs and coordinated Intelligent Transportation Systems (ITS) will be utilized for advance warning notifications
- Local roadways, streets, and intersections will be kept open to the greatest extent possible
- Notice of activities will be posted to the project web page and sent to media outlets and emergency responders
- A number of digital resources are available for motorists navigating the area including updates on the project web page, real-time web and app updates from Georgia 511, weekly email alerts, and updates from Georgia DOT social media channels including Facebook, Twitter, Instagram, and TikTok
