

PROJECT OVERVIEW

The *Transform 285/400* project is designed to help reduce traffic congestion and enhance safety in the area near the I-285/SR 400 interchange in metro Atlanta. This priority project adds new flyover ramps, new collector-distributor lanes, and other facilities to aid east-west travel along I-285 and north-south travel along SR 400.



GOALS AND OBJECTIVES

- Reduce traffic congestion
- Enhance safety
- Improve operational efficiency
- Reduce weaving along I-285 and SR 400
- Improve ramp geometry at I-285/SR 400 interchange
- Prevent worsening traffic delays over time
- Support regional growth and development

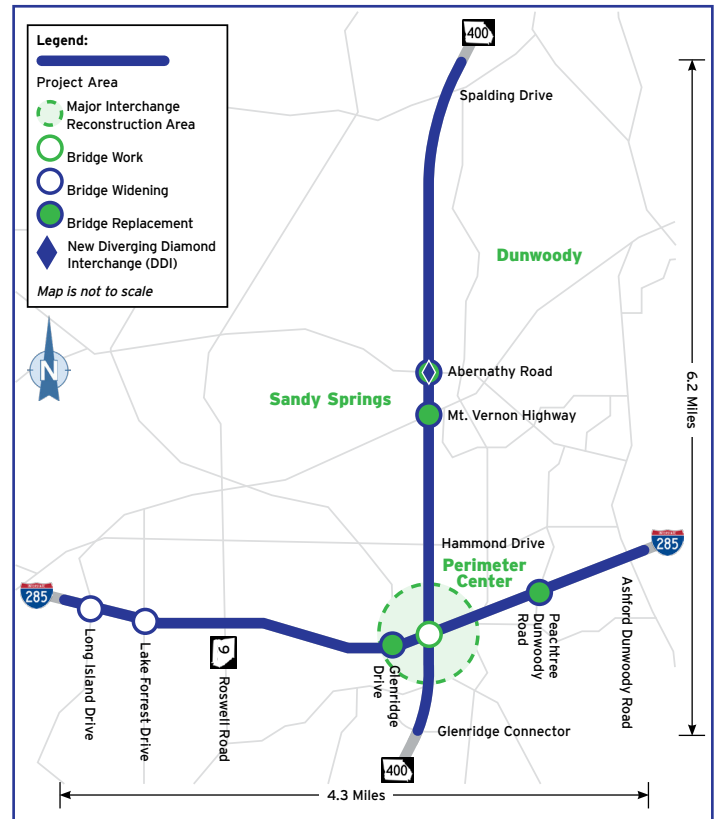
TRAFFIC IMPACTS DURING CONSTRUCTION

- Overnight work and lane closures are planned
- Local roadways, streets, and intersections will be kept open to the greatest extent possible
- Hospital signs will be maintained as will access for Emergency Service Providers at the Peachtree Dunwoody and Glenridge Drive ramps
- Changeable message signs and coordinated ITS systems will be utilized for advance warning notification
- Uniformed officers will direct traffic for lane closures
- Notice of activities will be posted to the project web page and sent to media outlets and emergency responders

QUICK FACTS

- All lanes are in final alignment on I-285 and SR 400, as well as Glenridge Drive, Peachtree Dunwoody Road, and Abernathy Road. The new ramps and connecting lanes along I-285 and SR 400 are also open to traffic. Final work such as paving, striping, ITS connections, etc., will continue throughout 2024.
- Project adds connecting lanes on SR 400 and I-285.
- Reconstruction of the Mount Vernon Highway bridge over SR 400.
- Abernathy Road and SR 400 interchange converted to a diverging diamond interchange (DDI).
- Reconstruction of three I-285 mainline bridges over Glenridge Drive, State Route 400, and Peachtree Dunwoody Road.
- North Perimeter Contractors (NPC), a subsidiary of Ferrovial Agroman US Corp, is the project developer/construction partner.
