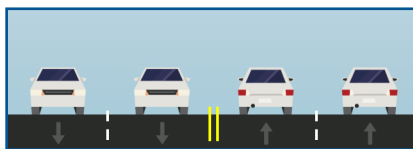

Project Overview

GDOT and the City of Atlanta have identified the need for safety improvements for pedestrians, bicyclists, and drivers on State Route (SR) 8/US 278/Donald Lee (D.L.) Hollowell Parkway. From 2013 to 2021, there were a total of 1,906 crashes, including five fatal pedestrian crashes, on the section of D.L. Hollowell Parkway from SR 280/James Jackson Parkway/Hamilton E. Holmes Drive to Stiff Street.

As such, GDOT and the City of Atlanta are collaborating on a traffic calming project on this section of D.L. Hollowell Parkway, with the goal of promoting safety for all roadway users by reducing vehicle speeds. This section of D.L. Hollowell Parkway is currently a four-lane road with two lanes in each direction and no median. The proposed project would convert D.L. Hollowell Parkway to a three-lane road, with one lane in each direction and a center two-way left turn lane. The proposed project is expected to decrease total crashes on this section of D.L. Hollowell Pkwy by 37%, with the potential for a larger decrease by creating space within the existing right-of-way for potential future improvements.

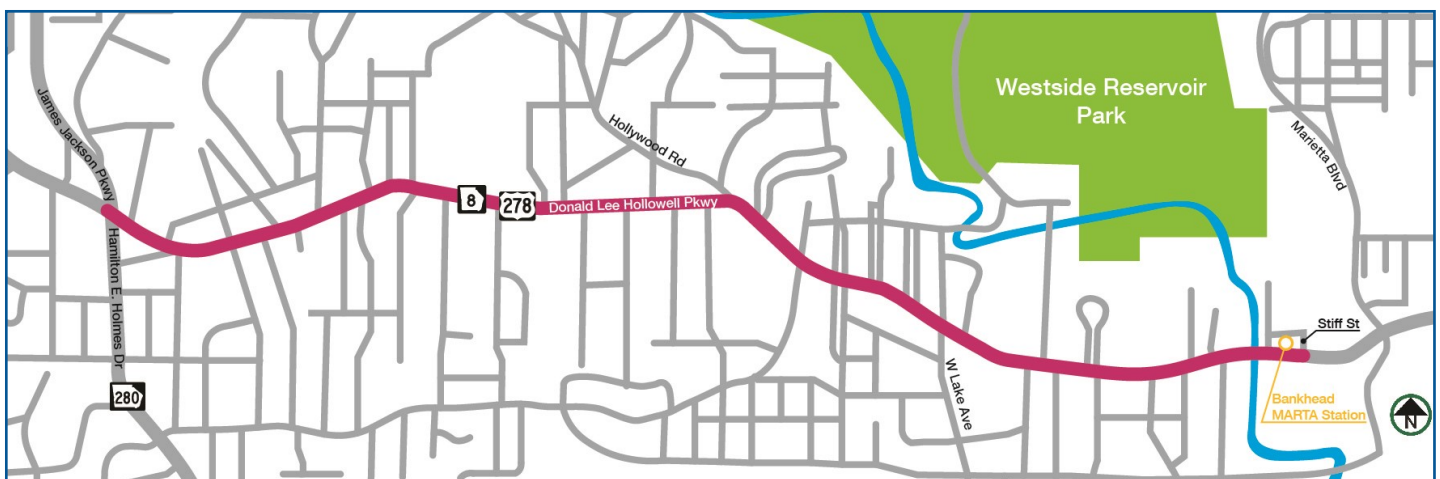
Proposed Change
