

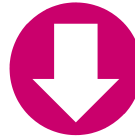
# SR 316 Planning Study

## Fact Sheet

### Overview

State Route (SR) 316 is a critical east-west transportation artery and one of Georgia's fastest-growing corridors. The SR 316 Planning Study is examining this corridor, a 40-mile section from Interstate 85 (I-85) in Gwinnett County to SR 10 in Oconee County. The study will result in recommended potential improvements to the corridor that could be implemented *in addition to* the ongoing SR 316 reconstruction projects.

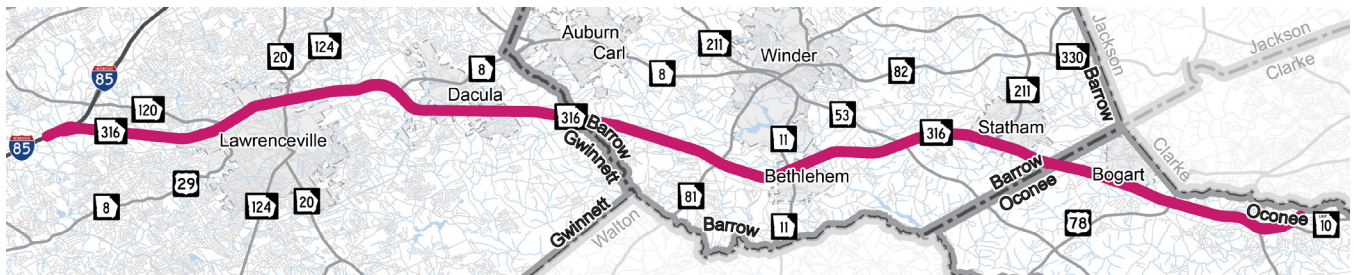
