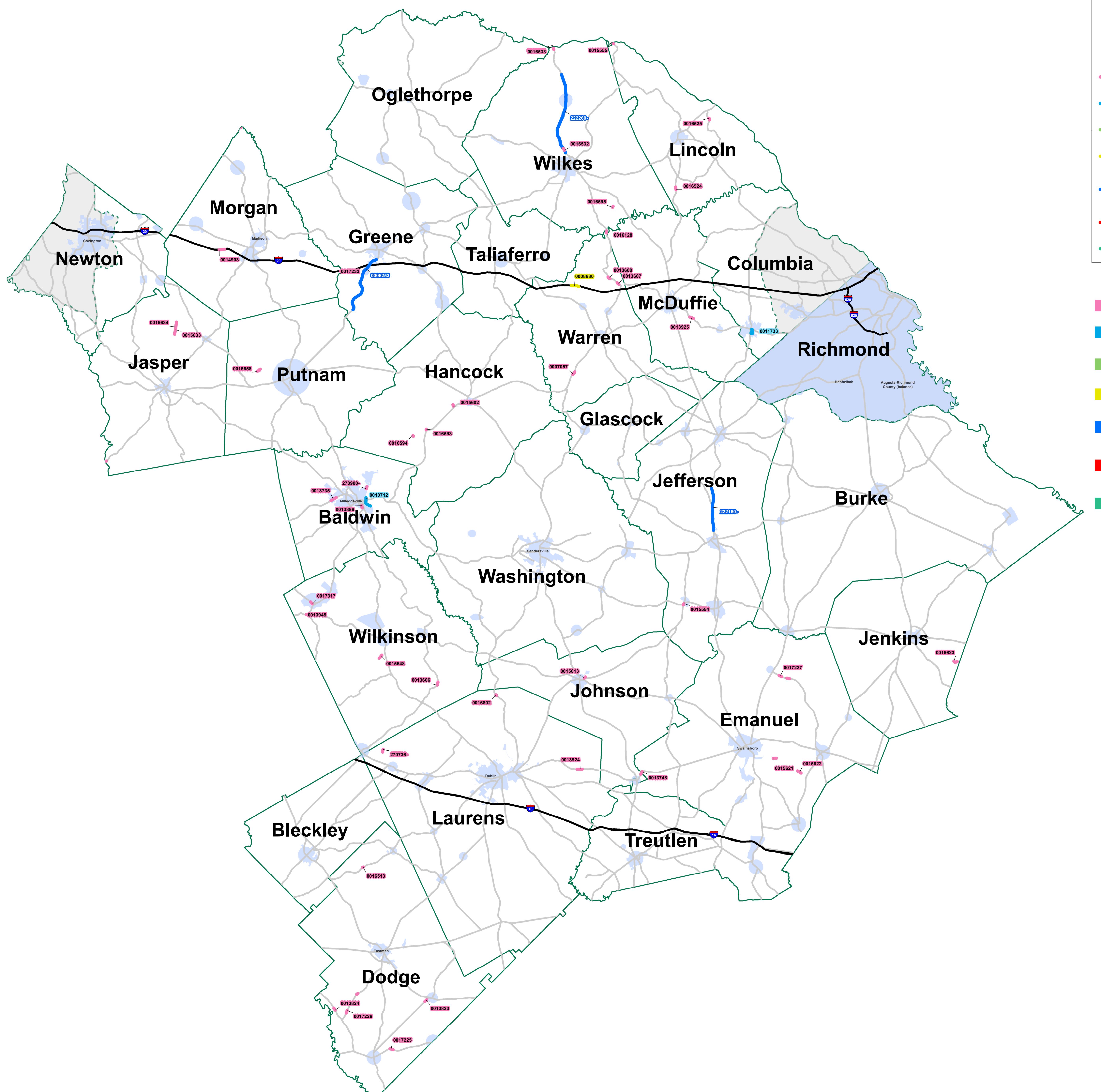

Glossary of Program Types

- Replacement:** Encompasses bridge and drainage replacements.
- Enhancement:** Upgrades existing facilities by adding features or improving infrastructure. Examples include adding a sidewalk to an existing road, installing street lights and landscaping along a sidewalk, and continuing an existing bike trail.
- Maintenance:** Inspects existing transportation infrastructure to assess need for repair or replacement. Examples include bridge inspections and engineering work.
- New Construction:** Creates new transportation infrastructure. Examples include roadway construction, new interchanges, and new truck lanes.
- Reconstruction/Rehabilitation:** Replaces or fixes existing infrastructure, often improving traffic operations. Examples include intersection improvements, adding dedicated turning lanes, and widening roads.
- Safety:** Improves intersections and roadway segments with high crash and/or injury rates. Examples include railroad crossing studies, conversion of intersections to roundabouts, and traffic signal analysis.
- Other:** Encompasses miscellaneous design, project management, and program administration costs. Examples include environmental review, permitting procedures, and construction management.
